

NABCOP ANALYSIS TIMELINE

It takes a long time for data on a breast cancer patient to be ready for inclusion in the NABCOP annual report. The graphic below outlines the process in England. Patients diagnosed (for example) in December 2017, will have data for investigations, initial treatments and subsequent treatments uploaded via COSD between February and August 2018 – meaning that final registration will not occur until September 2018. From October 2018, NCRAS can quality assure all 2017 data (January to December) and make it available to the NABCOP in December 2018 for statistical analysis.

Once the data has been analysed, the report can be written; this then has to be agreed by the project partners and funders before publication in May 2019.
